



#### Friday, June 24 | 7 to 9 pm

Meet **Artist Barb Swysgood** and experience her exhibit of intriguing two and three dimensional designs utilizing re-purposed materials. Live music by the singer/songwriters of **folk band Bohemian Highway**

#### Friday, July 29 | 7 to 9 pm

**Phoenix Rising Printmaking Cooperative**, a group of 12 dedicated printmaking artists, will exhibit a display of fine art prints including relief, intaglio, and lithographic processes. Live music will be provided by the **acoustic duo, Avalon 9**, featuring classic rock and Americana with rich vocal harmonies.

### MASTER WORKSHOPS | Work With a Creative Master at Sunbear!

#### July 6, 13, 20 • 6:00 - 9:00 pm • Make a Memory Vessel with Barb Swysgood

Memory or story vessels have a rich cultural, and often spiritual, history. A vessel or container features small items representative of a person's life or story attached or embedded onto the surface, creating a time capsule of memories and spirit. Explore techniques and themes in this three-dimensional workshop.

#### August 13 • 10:30 am - 3:30 pm • Monoprinting with Phoenix Rising Co-op

Printmakers Joan Tallan and Judith Steele will show you how to use three transparent inks to establish a diverse color palette and create a 3-plate final print. Start with your own drawing, painting or photograph for reference, and we will supply acrylic for the plates and all additional materials.
